- 4 **RESPECT TO IRAN.**

- 6 (1) in general, multilateral sanctions are more
- 7 effective than unilateral sanctions at achieving de-
- 8 sired results from countries such as Iran;

2 allies of the United States to impose such sanctions
3 as may be necessary to prevent the Government of
4 Iran from acquiring a nuclear weapons capability;

6 (3) the United States should continue to con-
7 sult with the 5 permanent members of the United
8 Nations Security Council and Germany (commonly
9 referred to as the "P5-plus-1") and other interested
10 countries regarding imposing new sanctions with re-
11 spect to Iran in the event that diplomatic efforts to
12 prevent Iran from acquiring a nuclear weapons capa-
13 bility fail.
