2 (b) LOAN AND GRANT TERMS AND CONDITIONS.—

3 (1) IN GENERAL.—Amounts made available
4 under this section shall be for direct loans, grants,
5 and direct loans that can be converted to grants to
6 eligible recipients that agree to an extended period
7 of affordability for the property.

8 (2) REPORTING GREENHOUSE GAS EMIS-
9 SIONS.—

10 (A) REPORTING REQUIREMENT.—A recipi-
11 ent of amounts made available under this sec-

1 tion shall annually report to the Secretary, until
2 the end of the extended period of affordability
3 described in paragraph (1), the scope 1 emis-
4 sions, scope 2 emissions, and scope 3 emissions
5 of the recipient for the preceding year.

6 (B) DEFINITIONS.—For purposes of this
7 paragraph, with respect to a recipient of
8 amounts made available under this section:

9 (i) DIRECT GREENHOUSE GAS EMIS-
10 SIONS.—The term “direct greenhouse gas
11 emissions” means greenhouse gas emis-
12 sions expressed in metric tons of carbon di-
13 oxide equivalent from operations that are
14 owned or controlled by the recipient.

15 (ii) GREENHOUSE GAS.—The term
16 “greenhouse gas” means carbon dioxide,
17 methane, nitrous oxide, nitrogen
18 trifluoride, hydrofluorocarbons,
19 perfluorocarbons, and sulfur hexafluoride.

20 (iii) INDIRECT GREENHOUSE GAS
21 EMISSIONS.—The term “indirect green-
22 house gas emissions” means greenhouse
23 gas emissions expressed in metric tons of
24 carbon dioxide equivalent that result from
25 the activities of the recipient, but occur at

1 sources not owned or controlled by the re-
2 cipient.

3 (iv) SCOPE 1 EMISSIONS.—The term
4 “scope 1 emissions” means direct green-
5 house gas emissions.

6 (v) SCOPE 2 EMISSIONS.—The term
7 “scope 2 emissions” means indirect green-
8 house gas emissions from the generation of
9 purchased or acquired electricity, steam,
10 heat, or cooling that is consumed by oper-
11 ations owned or controlled by the recipient.

12 (vi) SCOPE 3 EMISSIONS.—The term
13 “scope 3 emissions” means all indirect
14 greenhouse gas emissions that—

15 (I) are not scope 2 emissions;

16 and

17 (II) occur in the upstream activi-
18 ties or downstream activities of the
19 value chain of the recipient.
